PINEWOOD DERBY

What is it? It's a car race. Everyone buys a simple kit consisting of a block of wood, four standard derby wheels and stainless steel axle nails. There are various rules about how heavy cars can be so that they can be raced fairly. From there it's up to you and your child's imagination. You can hone the car into any shape and decorate it how you please. Then you can enter it for judging in one of the three age categories, and after that you can race it!

Entry categories All cars must be made this year. A car may be entered in one age division in the Best Design show and the Fastest Car race (one car per entrant).

For both events there will be three age divisions in fastest and best car categories.

- Infants (preschoolers to Year 2)
- Primary (Years 3-6)
- Open (all ages)

Prizes for 1, 2, 3 awarded in each category Most entusiastic - special prize.



You must start with the standard Pinewood Derby Kit and can shape or decorate it any way you want within the specification limits below. Your wheels must be the regulation wheels found in the kit. Kits can be ordered through www.rangers.org.au

Registration Each car will be inspected on registration and issued with an entry number. Cars that do not conform to the specification limits will be disqualified. Registration is free with entry to the festival. **Cars must be registered at the KV Hall between 9am and 10am on the festival day – Sunday 15 November.**
