BEEF CATTLE JUNIOR JUDGING COMPETITION

The South Coast and Tablelands Show Societies Inc (Group 5) have organised a Beef Cattle Junior Judging Competition to be held on Friday 19th February at Kangaroo Valley Showground commencing at 9.00am.

Competitors will be asked to judge three groups of cattle - consisting of four head in each group, placing them in their respective order of 1st, 2nd 3rd & 4th. Each group will judge the three breeds of cows in rotation. 50 points will be allocated for the placement of each group for a total of 150 points. Competitors will also be asked to complete some written questions (20 points). On completion of the judging the top marked competitors in the senior and intermediate sections will be asked to give over the microphone their comments on the placement of their first breed. A further 50 points will be allocated for this oral section.

Two competitors, aged over 15 and under 25 years as at 1st May 2010, will be selected on the day to represent Group 5 at the 2010 Sydney Royal Show to compete in the State Beef Cattle Junior Judging Competition.

Competitors can complete in only one Group Final but it is not necessary to reside within the boundaries of the Group conducting the Final. No competitor can represent more than one Show Society in any Group Final and no more than one group in a State Final. The winners of the National Final cannot compete at any level in the particular competition that they won.

Entries will be accepted on judging morning up until 8.30am. However, to assist with catering and administration it would be appreciated if schools could advise the number of anticipated competitors and send completed entry forms Wednesday 10th February, 2010 to the Secretary Sue Sharpe on 02 46580897 or mobile 0410545463.

It will be assumed that schools not replying by Wednesday 10th February will not be attending and will not be catered for.

OPEN JUDGING COMPETITION

SPECIAL REGULATIONS:

1. Age as at 1st March.
2. Junior or Senior classes may be combined at the Steward's discretion if total number of entries for that breed is 3 or less.
3. Duplicate or photo copies of Registration Certificate or Pure Bred Stud Cattle **MUST** accompany entries, which will be retained and returned on judging day.
4. All bulls over 12 months must have a ring attached to nose.
5. All females must be paraded with nose grip at all times.
6. A calf of the exhibit may be admitted if it is under the age of eight months on the day of the Show and is being suckled by the exhibit, R.A.S. regulation No. 6.
7. Exhibitors please supply own bedding.
8. All Steers must not be showing permanent teeth and can be purebred or crossbred.
