GENERAL INFORMATION

The Annual Show is conducted under the Rules and By-Laws of the Kangaroo Valley Agricultural and Horticultural Association Inc. The Committee reserves the right to alter or delete the program as it sees fit. Any accident occurring during the show must be reported to the Secretary or President and verified immediately on the day. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused by or through any exhibit; and it shall be a condition of entry such exhibitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident. Any complaints shall be made in writing to the Secretary within seven (7) days of the last day of Show. No verbal advice will be received at the Show.

JUNIOR CATTLE SECTION	FREE
POULTRY SECTION	Members \$1.00 per entry, Non-members \$1.00 per entry.
PAVILION SECTION	Members Nil, Non-members \$1.00 per entry.
JUNIOR PAVILION SECTION	FREE

All animals are on the Showground at owner's risk and are not the responsibility of the Show Committee.

No horses to be stabled in Cattle Tie-up area or led or ridden on top side of Oval.

All animals shown must have been the property and in possession of the exhibitor or member of household (except where specified) for at least one month prior to the Show.

A steward will be in attendance at the Pavilion to receive exhibits the afternoon and evening preceding Show.

All exhibits must be in place by 9.30 a.m. on day of Show.

Prize money (except Horse Section and Dairy & Beef Cattle Sections and Alpacas) will be posted to the Exhibitor within 28 days after the Show. Please assist by putting full address on entry form.

All exhibits in Pavilion MUST be collected on Saturday between 5.30 – 6.30 p.m. or Sunday 10.30 a.m. to 12 noon. All promotional material to be handed out only within the confines of your designated site. Waivers MUST be signed by ALL Exhibitors and Competitors.
