

RED BUS TICKETS

Did you know that certain operators of rural and regional bus services are required to issue a Regional Excursion Daily (RED) ticket to holders of a valid

- Pensioner Concession eCard
- NSW Seniors Card or
- War Widow/er's Card (NSW or Victoria)?

The RED ticket is a \$2.50 all day multi-ride ticket which may be used on services operated by Kennedy's and Berrima Coaches, but not on those operated by Priors Coaches. It is purchased from the driver on boarding the bus on presentation of one of the above cards. To check current timetables, phone Kennedy's on 4421 7596 and Berrima Coaches on 4871 3211.

The RED ticket should not be confused with a \$2.50 Seniors Ticket available for use on public transport in NSW, such as CountryLink rail or bus services. For example, if you hold a NSW Seniors Card, you would have to pay \$2.50 for a bus to Moss Vale, and another \$2.50 for a train to Sydney. In both cases the ticket covers the return journey on the same day only.
